

Camp Ida-Haven March Newsletter

We have reached the end of the online registration week, and want to thank you for your patience and understanding in working with us. Online registration week is a stressful time and each year we find a few more computer glitches, but we have done our best to remedy these and help as many children as possible get into camp. Below you'll find some follow-up information about registration.

CHECK YOUR ACCOUNT

Please take a few minutes to go online and check your account for the following:

- **Check the dates** your children are coming to camp and verify that they will work.
- Take another look at the **activities** you are signed-up for. If you want to make any changes, now is a good time to do it.
- Check your **contact info** for accuracy: e-mail address, physical address, and phone numbers
- Check to make sure your medical and consent **forms** are completed before arrival. From your account, click on your camper's name on the left. At the bottom of the screen under forms, if it is blank or says "incomplete", you can click on "view/edit" to finish the process. You can now take advantage of e-signature on this form so you do not need to fax or mail the form to us.

We appreciate those of you who have uploaded pictures of your children. It's fun to see them and helps us remember your child. We'll keep you updated on pertinent information as camp get closer. Please make sure that idahaven@idconf.org is in your address book so you will receive our emails.

OPTIONS IN YOUR ACCOUNT

The following are things you can sign-up for to add to your camper's experience. These items are all found under "Options" in your online account. Select the "edit" button beside "Options". This will ask you about the following choices.

Camp Picture and DVD: We offer a camp picture, which is an 8x10 group photo of everyone at camp during the week. This has a \$5 cost. Another neat memento of your child's week at camp is the camp DVD. This DVD is shot during the week, capturing the campers in their activities, during rec time, and at campfire. The DVD costs \$15, if ordered in advance. Note: It does not work well in Blue Ray.

Party Tin: We have a party tin available for sale. This tin has the Camp Ida-Haven logo on it and is given out for the Saturday night party. Inside the tin we pack an assortment of goodies: candy, trinket gifts, etc. The party tin is \$10.

T-Shirt Size: Each camper is given a t-shirt at Registration Check-in. Please mark your child's shirt size so we can plan ahead and have the correct size for your camper. The t-shirt has no extra cost.

Transportation: We offer bus service between Boise and Camp. The cost is \$20 each way. There is limited space and you must reserve a spot in advance.

Camp Store: We offer a "bank account" system for our camp store. You can deposit money under "store deposit" on your reservation details in your online account. This amount will be added to your total balance. An average deposit amount is \$20-50. The camp store offers various clothing items, toys, snow cones, and hygiene supplies. Please only put in the amount that you believe your child will spend. The store is open daily during the camp week. Additionally, the store is open on Sunday during check-out and registration for cash purchases.

WAITING LISTS

Camp filled very quickly again this year. If your child was unable to make a reservation but still wants to come, please make sure his/her name is on the waiting list for that session. If you have any difficulties, feel free to call us and we will do our best to help.

If you are on the waiting list, please make sure that you are on the correct list for the week of camp that you will be willing to accept should a spot open up. This helps us process the list quickly and efficiently. We will call you as soon as an opening becomes available.
